Prop B: Minimum Police Staffing and Five-Year Annual Funding Requests	<p>Amends the charter to allow for the creation of a new tax passed by voters to establish a police staffing fund that would increase the minimum staffing requirement each year until the City reaches a maximum of 2,074 officers.</p> <p>Alliance Stance: No</p>
Prop C: Real Estate Transfer Tax Exemption	<p>Waives the city's transfer tax for buildings that are converted from off to residential use.</p> <p>Alliance Stance: Yes</p>
Prop E: Police Department Policies and Procedures	<p>Allows the San Francisco Police Department to install and use public surveillance cameras and drones if they submit a policy to the Board of Supervisors within one year. Also allows the San Francisco Police Department to pursue suspects by car more easily and reduces paperwork requirements from officers.</p> <p>Alliance Stance: Yes</p>
